

MANAGEMENT OF STUDENTS AFFECTED BY ALCOHOL OR ILLICIT DRUGS POLICY

Policy

Glenroy Neighbourhood Learning Centre (GNLC) is committed to safety and welfare of all students. As far as practicable, the GNLC seeks to ensure:

- a. That all students undertake their activities unaffected by the use of alcohol and/or illicit drugs.
- b. GNLC is a place free of inadvertent social pressure to use and consume alcohol and/or illicit drugs.

As such;

- Illicit drugs are not permitted on the premises of GNLC at any time.
- Dealing or enticement to use illicit drugs is forbidden.
- No person is allowed to remain on the premises of GNLC if they are under the influence of alcohol and/or illicit drugs, chronicling or other substance abuse.
- If a student is affected by alcohol or illicit drugs and they are Under 18 years of age, their Parent/Legal Guardian will be contacted and asked to collect the student. Students will not be allowed to travel home on public transport alone.

If a student breaches this policy, the Student Disciplinary Procedure should be followed. Students may also be referred to external support services.

Scope

This Policy applies to all students enrolled at GNLC.

Any breach in this Policy will result in Student Disciplinary action.
